

Clean DuraMax Pro White Chairs in 3 Easy Steps

Use warm, sudsy water with regular dish-washing soap such as Palmolive Original or Dawn, and use these simple steps:

- Mix a mild solution with soap and water
- Use a soft, micro-fiber cloth to wipe the resin furniture in a circular pattern
- Rinse the chair with clean, plain water. Avoid using abrasive cleaners and sponges as these can scratch the resin surface. (Even hard plastic and metal brushes can do considerable damage to the surface.)

How to Remove Scuff Marks

Black scuff marks can be easily removed with Mr. Clean[®] Eraser Pads. Use a clean pad to erase the mark and then wipe down the chair with a wet cloth.

Please note: Even though our resin chairs contain UV stabilizers, the more you care for the chairs, the longer they will last. For this reason, we recommend that all resin furniture is stored in a dry place, out of direct sunlight, when not in use.
